We are delighted to welcome you to Rutland Sailing Club and hope that you will have a thoroughly enjoyable weekend in England's smallest county.

For anyone wishing to arrive on Friday, the club grounds will be open until 10.00pm for people wishing to drop boats off. The bar will also be open until 10.00pm for those you requiring liquid refreshment or collecting accommodation keys.

We will be unable to use the off site parking fields so all car parking will be within the RSC site. This means that space will be very tight, so we will require all road trailers and dinghies to be parked on the grass in front of the club house and on the beach (there is lots of beach at the moment!) and not in the car parking areas. There will be a team of marshals managing the traffic and parking on Saturday & Sunday mornings so please do follow their instructions and park your car and boat/s as directed. Please do use all the slipways throughout site as this will help considerably.

Our lease with our landlords doesn't allow any overnight stays, camping or motor homing within the club grounds. The camping field opposite the club (Rutland Water campsite – owned by a local farmer) is closed over the winter until April so we would urge all people visiting with motor homes or tents to have an alternative plan and book an offsite campsite. There are a number of other local sites which can be found on our website www.rutlandsc.co.uk It is a rule of the club that no dogs are allowed on site, please be aware of this before you arrive.

Catering from the servery on the first floor of the clubhouse will be available all weekend, with breakfast and lunch available every day and food available after sailing on Saturday. We would be very grateful if people could please use the outside entrances to the changing rooms and the balcony steps to the first floor, particularly when wet.

As you will appreciate the site will be very busy over the weekend with people, cars and boats so we would very much appreciate your cooperation in helping us avoid any accidents by not skateboarding, roller blading or cycling within the club grounds.

We hope you have a fantastic weekend at Rutland, if you need any information or help before or during your visit please do contact one of the office staff who will be pleased to help you. The club office is located just inside the main entrance to the club house.
